It is a wonderful thing when everything is in order, whether it be in our personal lives, our church, or our nation. When Josiah became King of Judah, everything was “out of order”, but the Lord used Josiah to set things back in order. Here are some biblical truths to help all of us to “set things in order” from II Chronicles, chapter 34.

Seek the Lord with a whole heart. Vs. 3

Stand against sin. Vs. 3-4. Agree with the Lord that all sin is wrong and then repent and remove the sin.

Repair what is broken. Vs. 8. Just as Josiah set out to repair the Temple, we need to repair those areas in our lives that are broken, such as relationships, commitments, prayer, etc.

Re-Discover God’s Word. Vs. 14-19. Just as the Law of God was found after years of absence in Josiah’s time, we need to rediscover the validity and veracity of God’s Word today.

The result of Josiah setting things in order was that he made a personal vow to follow the Lord and to be obedient to His Holy Word. He also led others to make that same commitment. May times of restoration and revival begin in our lives, our churches and our nation.
